The Lodge is ideally located in a beautiful and hilly area in South Lapland, at the foot of the higher Swedish mountains, and merely an hour from Vilhelmina and South Lapland Airport

## **ABOUT THE ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAM**

All our stays are exclusive with tailor-made programs. We want you to have a truly unique holiday, that meets your desires and expectations. At the same time, we want the flexibility to choose the activity of the day according to the weather conditions for the best experience possible, for you and for the animals. Life in the North, especially when it comes to outdoor activities, depends a lot on Nature. Instead of fighting against it, we prefer to make the most of it! Each winter month has something different to offer and will colour the stay accordingly.

Two Main Options to choose from:

**The Wild Musher : *our Wilderness & Animals option, with a slightly more authentic touch.***

You will spend time in nature and with the animals, especially the dogs, doing mostly activities involving them: with short and longer sled tours, snowshoes and/or skiing, learning to mush and take care of the dogs, and why not help us with grooming the trails with the snowmobile. It is the perfect option if you want to immerse yourself in Life up North, as a musher, have time to chill at the Lodge after a cold day outside and make a complete break from your usual life.

Depending on the length of your stay and your desires, we can take you on a day trip to one of the nearby Sápmi sites for a cultural touch or to the ski resort 😊

**The Active Explorer: *our sportier option***, for those who want to spend time with the animals but also go on a snowmobile trip, go downhill skiing, backcountry skiing and/or visit the area and Sápmi sites.

During your stay, depending on its length, you will go on several sled dog tours, and get a chance to try driving. We will also take you to the chosen activities, some guided by us, some by our partners.

**As all our programs are tailor-made, there's no strict lines between the two options. Let's create the perfect stay for you and have fun together and with the furry ones!**
